



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR COUNCIL MEMBERS AT MOTHEO TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING(TVET) COLLEGE IN TERMS OF SECTION 10(4)(b) OF THE CONTINUING EDUCATION AND TRAINING(CET) ACT 16 OF 2006 (AS AMENDED).

Motheo TVET College hereby invites members of the:

- (a) The public;
- (b) National organizations representing TVET students, University Principals, University of Technology Principals, TVET College Principals, other Higher Education Colleges, Private Higher Education Institutions, Private TVET Colleges, the further education sector, the distance education sector, educators, organized business, organized labour, provincial government, municipal government;
- (c) Members of the Business Community;
- (d) Research and Science councils; and
- (e) Relevant non-governmental organizations.

To nominate persons by virtue of the fact that they can give expression to:

- I. Ensuring that the functions of the council are performed according to the highest professional standards;
- II. Ensuring that the council is broadly representative of the TVET sector and its related interests;
- III. Ensuring that the council members have a thorough knowledge and understanding of the TVET sector and have a recognized qualification/s (Diploma or Degree), as well as verifiable experience accompanied by a solid grounding in ethical practices with a high level of accountability;
- IV. Appreciate the role of the TVET colleges in the reconstruction of the TVET Sector, and have a clear understating of Governments trajectory with regards to the sector as contained in the National Development Plan: Vision 2030;
- V. Ensure that members contribute to the strategic direction of the College, by offering knowledge and experience in strategic planning, including the development and delivery of college strategy, for the attainment of its short, medium, and long term goals;
- VI. Ensure that nominees have experience to engage and establish partnerships and linkages with industry for the purposes of Work Integrated Learning and Work Based Education for both student and lecturers.

- VII. Ensure that the Council is broadly representative of the Community served by the Public College in respect of race, gender, or disability; and
- VIII. Ensure that the nominated council members reside within reasonable distance from the College they will be serving, to reduce costs related to council committee meetings in terms of travel and accommodation.

- ii. He /She should be at a senior or executive management level at current employment;
